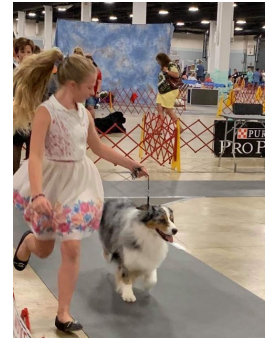
Gloria Askins, Legacy Setters

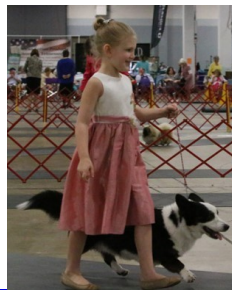
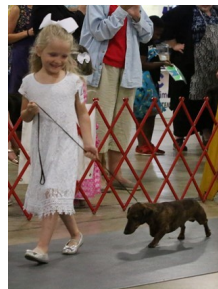
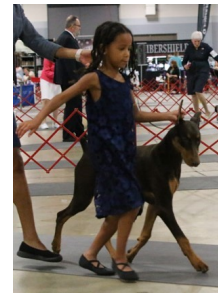
