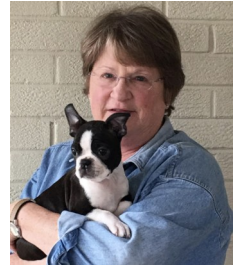

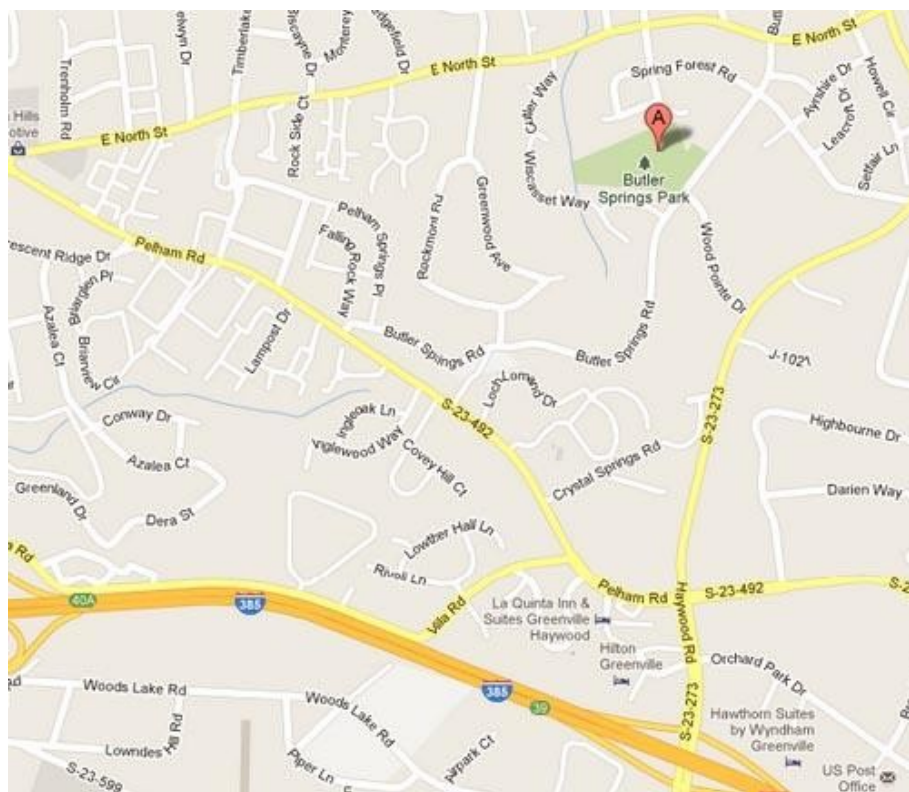

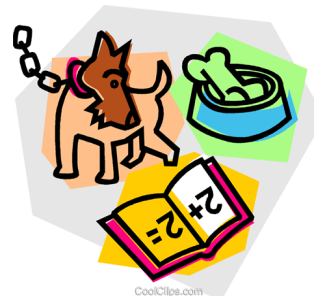
One more to go

The following two weekends he received an OH Sporting Group 3rd & 4th and another 5 pt major Select. He now has 23pts with 5 majors toward his GCH. We were also deeply honored that Gunner was selected by the Irish Setter Club of America Judges Education Committee to represent the breed standard in the Judges Education classroom training at our National Specialty last week!
