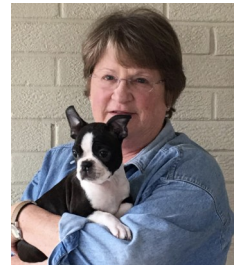

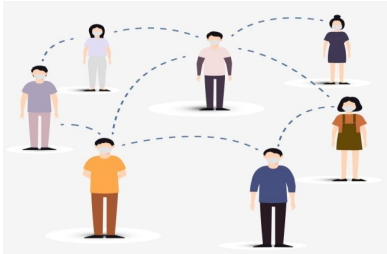

Update from Show Chair *Kris Harner*



Greenville Kennel Club Members:

Our show is just around the corner. We have been working around the clock on getting ready, with multiple trips to the convention center, measuring and planning the layout. I believe we have more than enough space to allow for social distance in the grooming area, we even believe we could have had a higher entry limit, but feel it is our responsibility to stay on the safe side. This year we will have rings grouped in four. There will be 8 rings in Hall1 and 8 rings in Hall2. We have separated the public xpens, all will be inside the building. Four down at the far end of Hall1 the other 4 in Hall 2.

We will not be allowing exhibitors to drive in, due to all the reserved grooming, for social distancing. At this time, we expect the building will be available to exhibitors to unload around 1:00pm.

Masks or face shield, will be required inside the building at all times, you will be allowed to lower your mask while gaiting your dog, but must pull it back up when you do the free bait.

We still have several vendors joining us this year, please stop by and thank them and if at all possible support a vendor.

I have sent out an email for volunteer sign up, I noticed some of you have signed up to do multiple jobs for the same hour. If you did, would you please choose only 1 sign up for that time period. Example: Club table 1 – 4pm and Grooming also 1 – 4pm. Choose which ever job you prefer and delete the other one.

Update from Show Chair Kris Harner continued

We will have some ring side crating, you will be required to have your name, breed and ring time on your crate. You will be allowed to set them up 15 min prior to ring time and will be required to remove them within 15 min. If you do not comply, you will not be allowed to have a crate ring side during the rest of these events.

We will make announcements for any changes. If you are done showing and not working or shopping and it looks crowded, we would like for you to leave.

We have EPA safe for humans and dogs sanitizer to be used around the building. We will be spraying door handles and ring mats. The stewards will have spray for the exam table and for the stewards table. There will be a few hand sanitizer pump sprayers around the ring clusters for you to use.

Each ring will have an entrance and an exit, armbands will be laid out on the stewards table for you to pick up, you will need to know your number, there will not be any catalogs to look it up.

I think I covered most everything, of course if you have any questions, feel free to contact me. We look forward to having a great safe event. Hope to see many of you at our meeting.

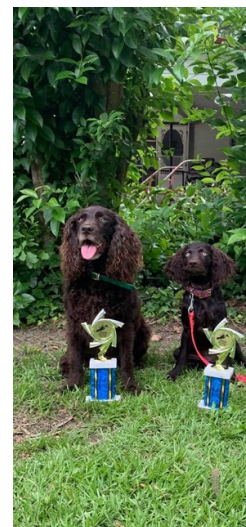

A TOTAL OF **10 TRICKS** ARE REQUIRED TO EARN THE INTERMEDIATE TRICK DOG TITLE. Must have the Novice Trick Dog Title; CGC is not required. No more than 2 Handler's Choice tricks (optional). Tricks must not have been previously submitted for Novice.

10 Intermediate tricks have been observed by evaluator and are checked below.
