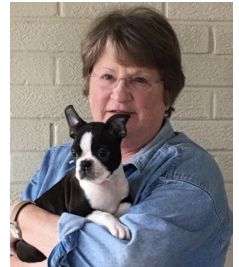

Dues for 2021 are \$25 for Individual, \$40 for Family, and \$15 for Associate Members. No dues are charged for Life Members and Junior Members.

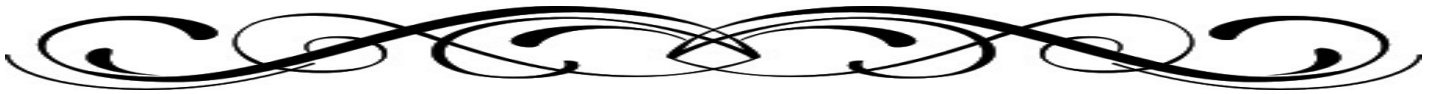

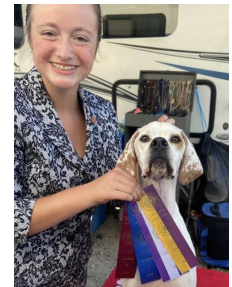

Southern Fire Griffons is pleased to announce that GCHG CH Southern Flash's Cloud Runner has been inducted into the American Wirehaired Pointing Griffon Association Show Dog Hall of Fame. Cloud Runner was the #1 male Griffon in the Breed and GCH systems for 2019 and is currently the #1 WPG in 2020 in the GCH system and #2 Griffon in the breed.



We are also thrilled to announce that our Jess GCHS CH Southern Jes A Lit'l Hunting Sensation JH CGC TKI NAVHDA VC UT1 UPT3 NA 1 has been inducted into the American Wirehaired Pointing Griffon Association Field Dog Hall of Fame. She is the first Griffon in the history of the breed to attain both Grand Champion Silver and earn the title Versatile Champion by passing the National Invitational of the North American Versatile Hunting Dog Association.



She has also received the AWPGA 2020 Korthal's Vision Award. The Korthals Vision Award recognizes those Griffons owned by AWPGA members that have demonstrated high achievement in both conformation and field events.



In addition, she has been awarded the AWPGA Capitaine Fracasse Challenge Trophy as the champion Wirehaired Pointing Griffon who has earned the greatest number of points in field performance events within the last calendar year.



Jess' offspring's accomplishments so far include 8 CH, 5 GCH, 2 Bronze GCH and 1 Gold GCH titles, the current #1 and #2 FCAT griffons, 2016 top Dock Diving Griff, 2 Royal Canin BOB Puppy winners. Multiple AKC hunt titles, BOB NOHS and 5 top 10 NOHS qualifiers. All 3 of her litters received Natural Ability Breeder Awards from the North American Versatile Hunting Dog Association and 18 of her puppies earned NAVHDA Natural Ability prizes.

We are very grateful that her achievements and contributions to the breed have been recognized by these three awards.
