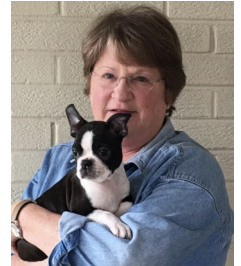

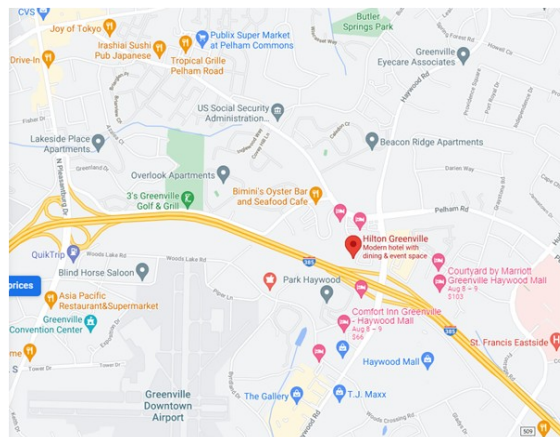

**This month is all about our Shows, we are excited to watch our shows unfold each year. We make changes and find ways to hopefully improve the events. This year, we will have AKC TV join us on Friday. They will be filming the Groups and BIS, and our Presentations to our show Dedications to the Jumper family. Sergeant Jumper's Daughter will be presenting the BIS Trophy. We will have snacks for the groups to celebrate his life. I hope each of you will be around the groups to show this family our gratitude for Sergeant Jumpers Service.**

**During our meeting next week, we will discuss where we need help and ask for volunteers. By then, I should have the schedule for your breed times, so you will know when you can help. ## *Message from Show Chair, continued*

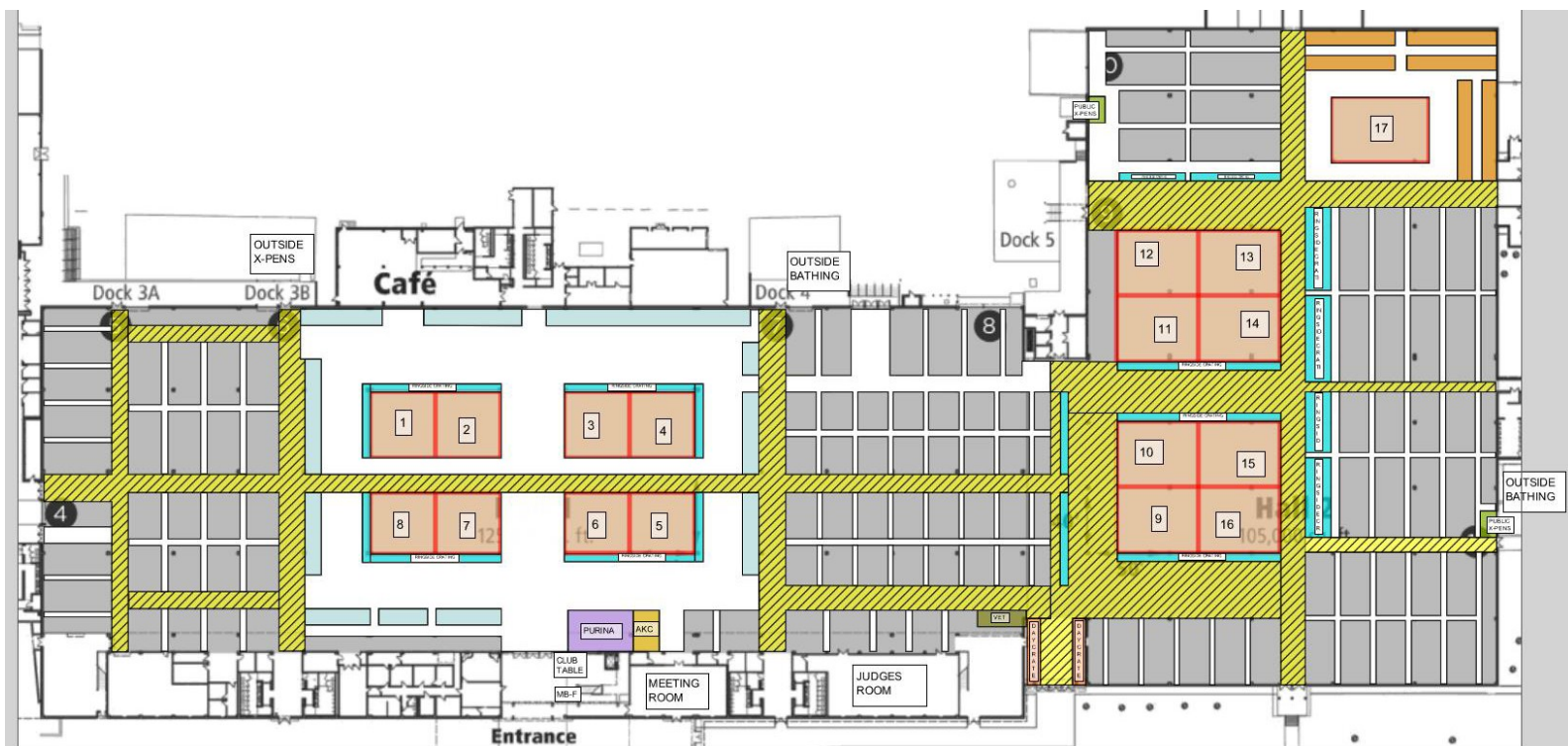

Also, my bred by male puppy Ty, earned his second major at the same show.

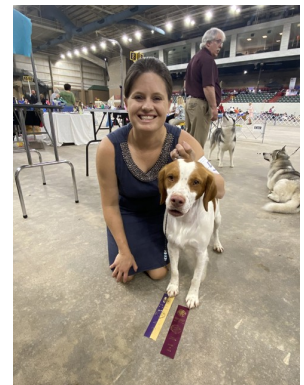


Ty also earned his Dock Novice title in Murrels Inlet, SC.

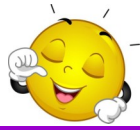
