Well, summer is here and it will soon be “Showtime”!

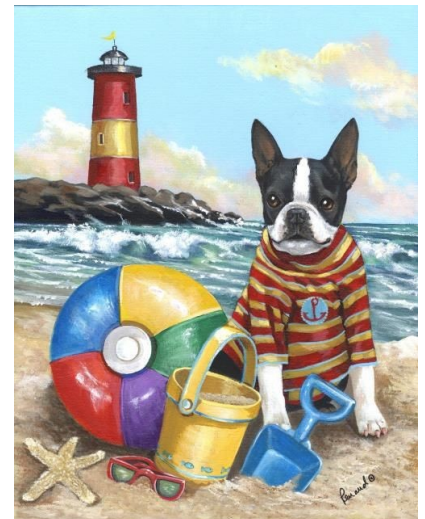
Kris and her crew have been hard at work and deserve many, many thanks from all of us. ***Please make plans to help out and make this the best show yet!***

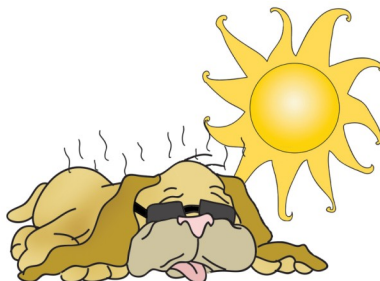

Judges Selection Committee

Judges Selection Committee has a different schedule of assignment to align with the show year. We will be adding a new member this year.

The Judge Selection Process is the process by which conformation dog show judges are selected and subsequently contracted for a specific show date. The process includes review of judges requested by Specialty clubs & our membership, previously hired judges & those that PKC would like to see on the panel.

The Judges Selection Committee has overall responsibility to select & negotiate contract terms with judges for our shows as well as work with our partner club(s) to coordinate the judging panel for our Dog Show Cluster. Assignments to the committee are a four (4) year commitment. The first two (2) years as a committee "member" to learn how the process works and the 3rd & 4th year as the committee Chairperson to run the Committee

Any "Active" club member (see Membership section of Policies & Procedures for definition) may apply to serve on this committee. **The ideal candidate should have the following experience:**

- Must be knowledgeable about judges with good reputations who will draw strong entries across multiple groups and be able to judge on multiple days of the cluster
- Must have excellent people skills & be able to diplomatically negotiate in the best interest of GKC and the cluster
- Must have excellent computer skills including an in depth knowledge of Excel
- Must be very familiar with AKC rules concerning judges and their assignments
- Must be able to meet hard deadlines
- Must have time to attend Cluster Meetings (possibly in Charlotte) and handle a large volume of emails in a timely manner
- Should have experience contacting & hiring judges including contract negotiation

Anyone who wishes to serve on this committee should send an email to the board (jcstribling@bellsouth.net) stating their specific experience that fulfills the above criteria and they should further state how their assignment will benefit this committee and our club. **The deadline for submission is July 15th of every EVEN numbered year.** (2018, 2020 ...)

The board works with the current Judges committee to select the best candidate.

Breeds I've owned- *Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs and many "Carolina ditch dogs" throughout the years*

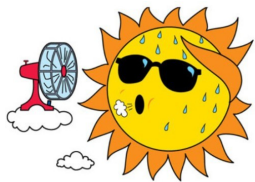
